(WebNet) filed its application requesting a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri. In its proposed tariff, WebNet set forth the standard waivers which would be waived as applied to its tariff, except instead of including 4 CSR 240-30.040 in its entirety, WebNet listed 4 CSR 240-

30.040(1),(2),(3),(5),(6). WebNet's application is inconsistent with its proposed tariff and, therefore, it is deficient. WebNet is directed to file an amended pleading or tariff sheet correcting its request for standard waiver of statues and rules in such a manner as to make the two documents consistent no later 4 p.m. on September 15, 1999.

Also, there is no indication on WebNet's application or cover letter that the Office of the Public Counsel has been served with this initial pleading as required by Section 386.710.2, RSMo. (1994). The Applicant is directed to inform the Commission of its compliance with Section 386.710.2, RSMo. (1994).
