## NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY

On February 25, 1999, Falcon/Capital Cable Limited Partners, L.P. (Falcon) filed its application for a certificate of service authority to provide competitive basic local exchange telecommunications services in the exchanges serving Jefferson City and Columbia, Missouri. Regulation 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(F) requires that all applications "shall be subscribed and verified by affidavit[.]" Falcon's application contains a verification which is not in the form of an affidavit.

Likewise, Regulation 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(C) requires, where the applicant is a partnership, that the application be accompanied by a copy of the partnership agreement. The regulation does not distinguish between foreign and domestic partnerships.
