**NOTICE AND ORDER REGARDING INADEQUATE NOTIFICATION  
OF MERGER AND NAME CHANGE**

On June 10, 1998, IXC Long Distance, Inc. (IXCLD) and Network Long Distance, Inc. (Network) filed a Notification of Merger and Name Change. This notification is inadequate as it does not meet the requirements specified in the Order Approving Merger issued by the Public Service Commission June 2, 1998. This Order Approving Merger stated that if Network intended to change its name after the merger to Eclipse Telecommunications, Inc., it must file an application with the Commission for acknowledgment of the change of name, along with the appropriate documentation from the Missouri Secretary of State's Office and either a new tariff bearing the new name, or an adoption notice.

As Network has not complied with this provision, it is directed to file the appropriate documentation for the change of name within 30 days.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That Network Long Distance, Inc. file, within 30 days of the issue date of this order, an application with the Commission for acknowledgment of the change of name, along with the appropriate

documentation from the Missouri Secretary of State's Office and either a new tariff bearing the new name, or an adoption notice.

2. That this order shall become effective on August 13, 1998.
