ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

On December 15, 1986, St. Joseph Light and Power Company (Company) filed information in Case No. AO-87-48 concerning the impact of the Tax Reform Act of 1986 (1986 Act) on the Company. A Stipulation and Agreement was executed by Staff, Company and Public Counsel which involves a reduction of the Company's electric service rates as a result of the 1986 Act. On February 5, 1987, a joint motion was filed which requested approval of the Stipulation and Agreement and an order allowing the tariffs attached to the stipulation to become effective on less than 30 days notice for good cause shown. On February 11, 1987 the Stipulation and Agreement was approved to become effective for service rendered on or after February 14, 1987. On February 13, 1987, the company filed revised tariffs with an issue date of February 13, 1987 and an effective date of February 14, 1987.

The Commission is of the opinion that the tariff sheets filed February 13, 1987, should be allowed to become effective for electric service rendered on or after February 14, 1987.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the following sheets submitted February 13, 1987 by St. Joseph Light and Power Company of St. Joseph, Missouri for the purpose of decreasing rates for electric service provided to customers in its Missouri service area be and they are, hereby approved and made effective for electric service rendered on and after February 14, 1987.
