ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On March 9, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed and its motion asking the Commission to cancel the certificate of authority and accompanying tariff of Digital Dial Communications, Inc. (DDCI). DDCI was originally granted a certificate of service authority by the Commission to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services on August 28, 1996, in Case Number TA-97-26.

On May 26, 2000, the Commission issued an Order Directing Filing which directed Staff to give notice of its Motion to Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Accompanying Tariff by mailing a copy thereof to DDCI by certified United States Mail, return receipt requested. That Order further directed Staff to file a pleading in this case advising the Commission whether the same was delivered or was returned. Staff has not yet filed such a pleading.

Therefore, the Commission will direct Staff to file, within ten days from the effective date of this order, a pleading advising the Commission as to the status of its compliance with the Commission's Order of May 26, 2000.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file, within ten days from the effective date of this order, a pleading advising the Commission as to the status of its compliance with the Commission's Order of May 26, 2000.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on August 2, 2000.
