

ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF THE
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

By Order issued on July 13, 2000, the Commission scheduled a prehearing conference for August 2. On July 20, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) filed a Motion for Continuance of the Prehearing Conference. SWBT indicates that its counsel will be unavailable on August 2. The motion requests that the hearing be rescheduled for August 4, 7 or 8. The motion states that counsel for all other parties have indicated that they have no objection to rescheduling the prehearing conference.

3. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than August 14, 2000.
