STATUS UPDATE

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) and for its status update in this matter respectfully states:

1. On March 9, 2000, the Staff filed a motion recommending that the Commission cancel Call Plus of Delaware, Inc.'s (Call Plus) certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services, granted on August 19, 1997 in Case No. TA-97-546, and accompanying tariff. Staff gave notice of its motion via United States Mail to Mr. James Giannoit, President of Call Plus, and to Call Plus' attorney who filed the application. The United States Postal Service (USPS) returned the letter addressed to Mr. Giannoit as undeliverable.
