## ORDER GRANTING WAIVER OF SECTION 392.240, RSMo (1994)

Digital Access Corporation of Missouri, Inc. (DACMI) applied to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) on May 12, 2000, for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local, local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri under Sections 392.420 - .440 RSMo (1994)<sup>1</sup>, and Sections 392.410 and .450, RSMo (Cum. Supp. 1999). DACMI asked the Commission to waive Section 392.240(1), RSMo, among other statutes and rules.

On July 12, 2000, DACMI filed a Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement (Agreement) signed by all the parties. The Agreement did not reference DACMI's request for waiver of Section 392.240(1) relating to rates, rentals, service and physical connections.

The Commission finds that it is appropriate in a competitive environment to grant DACMI's request for waiver of Section 392.240(1). The Commission will grant DACMI's request for waiver of Section 392.240(1).

The requirement for a hearing is met when the opportunity for hearing has been provided and no proper party has requested the opportunity to present evidence. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989). Since no objection has been filed to the request for waiver of Section 392.240(1), the Commission may grant the relief requested based on the application.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the request for waiver of Section 392.240(1), RSMo (1994), regarding rates-rentals-service and physical connections filed by Digital Access Corporation of Missouri, Inc., on May 12, 2000, is granted.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on October 27, 2000.
  - 3. That this case may be closed on October 28, 2000.
