## STATUS UPDATE

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) and for its status update in this matter respectfully states:

- 1. On March 9, 2000, the Staff filed a motion recommending that the Commission cancel Digital Dial Communication, Inc.'s (Digital) certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services, granted on August 28, 1996 in Case No. TA-97-26, and accompanying tariff. Staff gave notice, via United States Mail, of its motion to Mr. James McKenzie, President of Digital, and to Digital's attorney who filed the original application. The United States Postal Service (USPS) returned the letter addressed to Mr. McKenzie as undeliverable.
- 2. On May 26, 2000, the Commission issued an order directing Staff to give notice of its motion to cancel Digital's certificate of service authority and tariff via certified United States Mail, return receipt requested.
- 3. In accordance with the Commission's order, Staff gave notice, via certified United States Mail return receipt requested, to Mr. McKenzie and to Digital's attorney of Staff's motion recommending the Commission cancel Digital's certificate of service authority and tariff. Subsequently, the USPS returned the letter addressed to Mr. McKenzie as undeliverable and



marked "Attempted, Not Known." The USPS returned the receipt showing delivery of the letter addressed to Digital's attorney.
