#### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) cancel the certificate of service authority to provide basic local exchange telecommunications service of JATO Communications Corp. JATO Communications Corp. never filed a proposed tariff so there is no tariff to cancel.
- 2. The Commission's authority to cancel this certificate is pursuant to section 392.410.5 RSMo Supp. 1999.
- 3. The Staff concludes that surrender of the certificate is not detrimental to public interest because JATO Communications Corp. states that it has no customers in Missouri.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority to provide basic local exchange telecommunications service of JATO Communications Corp.

On March 17, 2000, JATO Communications Corp., (JATO), a competitive telecommunications company, filed an Application to Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Tariff. JATO was certificated to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services on March 25, 1999 in Case No. TA-99-148. According to the Application, JATO does not currently serve any customers in Missouri.

The Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff) has no objections to JATO's request and recommends that the Commission issue an order to cancel JATO's certificate of service authority to provide basic local exchange telecommunications service at its earliest convenience. Although the application also requests cancellation of JATO's tariff, JATO never filed a proposed tariff so there is no tariff to cancel. The Staff is unaware of any other filing which affects or which would be affected by this proposal.
