

ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On March 9, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion to open a case and cancel the certificate of service authority for Call Plus of Delaware, Inc. (Call Plus). Call Plus was originally granted a certificate of service authority by the Commission to provide intrastate inter-exchange telecommunications services on August 19, 1997, in Case No. TA-97-546.

On May 31, 2000, the Commission issued an Order Directing Filing which directed Staff to give notice of its Motion to Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Accompanying Tariff by mailing a copy thereof to Call Plus by certified United States Mail, return receipt requested. That Order further directed Staff to file a pleading in this case advising the Commission whether the same was delivered or was returned. Staff has not yet filed such a pleading.

Therefore, the Commission will direct Staff to file, within ten days from the effective date of this order, a pleading advising the Commission as to the status of its compliance with the Commission's Order of May 31, 2000.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file, within ten days from the effective date of this order, a pleading advising the Commission as to the status of its compliance with the Commission's Order of May 31, 2000.

2. That this Order shall become effective on August 2, 2000.

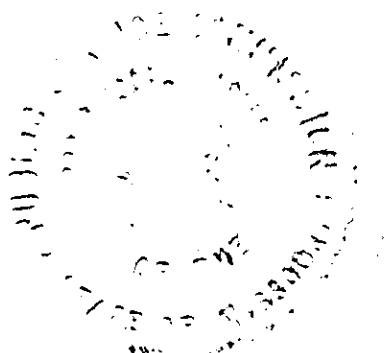
