


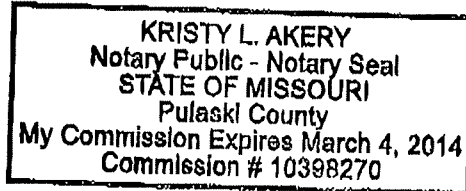

Dear Hunter's Pointe Water System Customer,

We wish to inform you that we have reached an agreement to transfer the Hunter's Pointe Water System that serves you, to the City of Waynesville, Missouri (Waynesville), effective later this year, pending the approval of the Missouri Public Service Commission. You will be notified of the specific date if and when a transfer date has been determined.

Waynesville owns, operates and maintains electric, natural gas and water distribution systems and currently provides water service to approximately 1,795 customers.
