

expiration of the specified period permit the act if the failure to act was the result of excusable neglect or other good cause shown.

7. Good cause exists to grant the MIEC's motion and to permit the filing of its Suggestions. Counsel for the MIEC did not notice the 1:00 p.m. deadline established by the Commission's May 11 order, and erroneously believed that its response to the Staff's recommendation could be filed on EFIS at a later time on that day. MIEC respectfully submits that its failure to file its response by 1 p.m. today as ordered by the Commission is the result of excusable neglect, and that good cause exists to permit Suggestions to be filed out of time due to the importance of the issue to Noranda Aluminum and the possibility of the Commission's expedited consideration of Sheet No. 62.5 separately from other compliance tariff issues that may be raised by the parties on May 15.

8. The MIEC respectfully submits that no party will be prejudiced by the delay in the filing of the MIEC's response.

WHEREFORE, the MIEC requests that the Commission issue an order granting leave for the MIEC to file its Suggestions in Support of Staff's Recommendation.
