**RESPONSE TO STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) and, in response to the Staff Recommendation, states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission):

1. On April 21, 2017, MAWC filed an *Application and If Necessary, Motion for Waiver, seeking a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* (“Application”) for authority to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a water system and sewer system in an area of St. Louis County, Missouri known as Pevely Farms.

2. On June 20, 2017, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a Staff Recommendation and an associated Memorandum, wherein it recommended approval of the Application with conditions described in the Memorandum. The Memorandum identifies recommendations 1-16. (Memo, p. 6-7)

3. MAWC has no objection to recommendations 1-16.

**WHEREFORE**, Missouri-American Water Company prays the Commission consider this Response to Staff Recommendation and, thereafter, issue its order granting MAWC’s
