PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND REQUEST TO CANCEL PREHEARING CONFERENCE

COMES NOW, Southern Union Company, d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy ("MGE" or "Company"), and, on behalf of MGE, the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") and the Office of the Public Counsel ("Public Counsel"), states as follows:

- 1. The Commission's September 20, 2011 Order Directing Filing directed the parties to file available dates for a pre-hearing conference to convene between October 3 and 13, 2011. - For data requests served after filing of direct testimony and prior to the filing of rebuttal testimony, the response time for all data requests shall be 10 calendar days and 5 business days to object or notify that more than 10 calendar days will be needed to provide the requested information.
- For data requests served after filing of rebuttal testimony, the response time for all data requests shall be 5 calendar days and 3 business days to object or notify that more than 5 calendar days will be needed to provide the requested information.
- 3. Moreover, the parties request that the Commission waive 4 CSR 240-2.045(2) and 2.080(11) with respect to prefiled testimony and other pleadings, and treat filings made through the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) as timely filed if filed before midnight on the date the filing is due.
- 4. Because the parties have reached agreement as to the matters contained herein, they therefore request that the Commission cancel the prehearing conference currently scheduled for October 6, 2011, so that they may instead focus on the agreed to events.

WHEREFORE, MGE, Staff and the Public Counsel respectfully request that the Commission issue its order adopting the schedule proposed herein and cancel the

prehearing conference currently scheduled for October 6, 2011.
