ANSWER AND RESPONSE TO ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Comes now Respondent NetWolves Network Services, Inc., doing business as

Norstan Network Services, Inc., ("NNSI") and as and for its Answer to the Complaint

filed by the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and as and for its

Response to the Order to Show Cause issued by the Missouri Public Service

Commission ("the Commission") in the above-captioned proceeding, states as follows:

ANSWER TO STAFF'S COMPLAINT

- 1. NNSI admits the factual allegations of Paragraph 1 of the Staff's Complaint.
- 2. NNSI admits the factual allegations of Paragraph 2 of the Staff's Complaint.
- 3. NNSI admits the factual allegations of Paragraph 3 of the Staff's Complaint, and states further that it has timely filed its annual registration materials with the Missouri Secretary of State.
- 4. NNSI admits the factual allegations of Paragraph 4 of the Staff's Complaint.

5. NNSI admits the factual allegations of Paragraph 5 of the Staff's Complaint, but states further that such contact information is out of date and that the correct current contact information is:

Norstan Network Services, Inc. 4710 Eisenhower Blvd., Suite E8 Tampa, FL 33634.

- 6. Paragraph 6 of the Staff's Complaint states a legal conclusion to which no response is required, but NNSI does not dispute the Staff's legal conclusion.
- 7. Paragraph 7 of the Staff's Complaint states a legal conclusion to which no response is required, but NNSI does not dispute the Staff's legal conclusion.
- 8. NNSI lacks information sufficient to admit or deny the factual allegations of Paragraph 8 of the Staff's Complaint, but states that is has not been able to locate such a letter from the Executive Director of the Commission in any of NNSI's records.
- 9. NNSI admits the factual allegations of Paragraph 9 of the Staff's Complaint, but states that such failure to file was not willful not intentional on NNSI's part.
- 10. NNSI lacks information sufficient to admit or deny the factual allegations of Paragraph 10 of the Staff's Complaint, but states that it has not been able to locate such a letter from the Commission's General Counsel in any of NNSI's records.

- 11. NNSI lacks information sufficient to admit or deny the factual allegations of Paragraph 11 of the Staff's Complaint, but states that it has not been able to locate such a letter from the Commission's General Counsel in any of NNSI's records.
- 12. NNSI admits the factual allegations of Paragraph 12 of the Staff's Complaint.
- 13. Paragraph 13 of the Staff's Complaint states a legal conclusion to which no response is required.
- 14. Paragraph 14 of the Staff's Complaint states a legal conclusion to which no response is required.
- 15. Paragraph 15 of the Staff's Complaint states a legal conclusion to which no response is required.
- 16. Paragraph 16 of the Staff's Complaint states a legal conclusion to which no response is required.
- 17. Paragraph 17 of the Staff's Complaint states a legal conclusion to which no response is required.

ADDITIONAL FACTS RESPONSIVE TO STAFF'S COMPLAINT

- 18. The parent corporation of NNSI, NetWolves Corporation, entered the protection of the United States Bankruptcy Court on May 21, 2007, in the Middle District of Florida, under Case No. 8:07-bk-4186-PMG. That proceeding was initiated under Chapter 11 of the U. S. Bankruptcy Code, and NNSI was included as a named debtor (under Case No. 8:07-bk-4193-PMG.)
- 19. On October 27, 2007, NetWolves Corporation submitted, on behalf of itself and all its affiliates including NNSI, a Joint Plan of Reorganization.
- 20. The Bankruptcy Court's Final Decree and Certificate of Substantial Consummation did not become effective until March 5, 2009, per the Court's Order dated April 27, 2009.
- 21. During the 23 months of bankruptcy proceedings, NNSI management personnel were consumed with working through the reorganization process, and were distracted from regulatory issues in several states, including Missouri.
- 22. NNSI management were not aware of the need for an annual filing with the Commission separate and in addition to the annual corporate filing with the Missouri Secretary of State, and believed mistakenly that the Secretary of State filings were sufficient to remain in good standing for the company's operations in Missouri.

- 23. NNSI received a copy of the Complaint in April 2009, and for the first time became aware after consultation with telecommunications counsel of the need for a separate annual filing with the Commission.
- 24. NNSI has completed and filed with the Commission Annual Report-Competitive

 Telecommunications Carrier forms for calendar years 2007 and 2008. Copies of
 those completed Reports are attached hereto as Exhibits 1 and 2.
- 25. NNSI did not intend to fail to comply with the Commission's filing requirements or to obstruct the Commission's operations in any way. NNSI's failure to file a 2007 Annual Report was inadvertent and due to its distraction during bankruptcy.

RESPONSE TO ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

- 26. On May 1, 2009 the Commission issued its Order to Show Cause in this proceeding, directing NNSI to show why it should not be found to have defaulted on a response to the Staff's Complaint.
- 27. When NNSI received the Staff's Complaint, NNSI consulted with counsel, and counsel for NNSI communicated with counsel for the Staff regarding an appropriate response.
- 28. NNSI believed that it had in fact filed a 2007 Annual Report with the Commission, and continued to search its records to recover a copy of that filing.

- It was NNSI's intention to demonstrate that the Staff's assertion regarding a failure to file was in error by producing a copy of the 2007 filing.
- 29. When that search was completed, NNSI discovered that all it had filed was its 2007 Annual Report with the Missouri Secretary of State, not with the Commission.
- 30. As a result of that search, NNSI did not immediately respond to the Staff's Complaint.
- 31. NNSI has now answered Staff's Complaint, and explained the reason behind its failure to file its 2007 Annual Report.
- 32. NNSI believes it has now responded fully and fairly to the Staff's Complaint, and requests that the Commission accept and give full credit to its Answer (as stated above.)
- 33. NSI has also been engaged in discussions with Commission Staff regarding compliance with the Commission's requirements and possible settlement of the Complaint.

CONCLUSION

NNSI requests that the Commission:

 find and determine that NNSI's failure to timely file its 2007 Annual Report was unintentional and inadvertent, and not an intended violation of the Commission's regulatory requirements;

- find and determine that NNSI has now fully and fairly answered the Staff's
 Complaint, and accept NNSI's Answer as though timely filed; and,
- 3. toll the procedural schedule for this matter so as to permit NNSI to complete discussions with the Commission's Staff regarding a possible settlement.
