## **MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC), and, in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), moves the Commission for expedited treatment of MAWC's tariff sheet, filed on March 29, 2006:

1. On March 28, 2006 (effective April 7, 2006), the Commission issued its Order Approving an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge But Rejecting Tariff wherein the Commission rejected the tariff sheet filed by MAWC on January 3, 2006 (YW-2006-0520), and authorized MAWC to file a tariff to impose an ISRS as specified in the Order.

2. Concurrently, with the filing of this Motion, MAWC filed a tariff sheet in order to comply with the Commission Order (P.S.C. MO. NO. 6, 2<sup>nd</sup> Revised Sheet No. RT 18.0) (attached hereto as **Appendix A**). This tariff sheet carries a proposed effective date of April 28, 2006 (30 days), and was assigned tracking number YW-2006-0739. MAWC's EFIS filing indicated that it would seek to have the tariff sheet made effective as of April 7, 2006.

3. The ISRS process is authorized by Sections 393.1000 through 393.1006 RSMo, and Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.650. Its goal is to provide eligible water corporations with the ability to recover, on a timely basis, certain infrastructure replacement costs outside of a formal rate case filing via the ISRS. The Commission has authorized such an ISRS in this case and there are no further procedures to be completed in this case. Granting this Motion will


afford MAWC the timely rate relief which the Commission has found to be justified. As such, Commission action as requested herein will cause no negative effect on MAWC's customers or the public generally.

4. Accordingly, MAWC seeks the Commission's order allowing the proposed tariff sheet to go into effect on April 7, 2006.

5. The subject tariff sheet and this Motion have been filed as soon as possible after the issuance of the Commission's Order Approving an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge But Rejecting Tariff in this case.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, MAWC respectfully requests the Commission to grant MAWC's Motion for Expedited Treatment and approve MAWC's proposed tariff sheet (YW-2006-0739) effective April 7, 2006.

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
