On June 17, 1999, Axces, Inc. (Axces) and Gemini II, Inc. (Gemini) (jointly referred to herein as the "Applicants"), filed a joint application in Case No. TM-99-601, requesting Commission approval of the acquisition of all issued and outstanding common stock of Axces to Gemini.

Axces received a Certificate of Service Authority to provide Intrastate Telecommunications Services in Missouri, effective on December 22, 1995 in Case No. TA-96-95. Axces is a privately held Delaware corporation as is Gemini.

The proposed merger would have resulted in Gemini acquiring all of the outstanding and issued shares of Axces common stock for equitable consideration. The transaction sought to be approved involved a merger of Axces with and into Axces Acquisition, Inc. Axces Acquisition, Inc. was to emerge as the surviving corporation and it is a wholly owned subsidiary of Gemini.

Axces Acquisition Inc. subsequently applied for and was granted a Certificate of Service Authority in Case No. TA-2000-179.

On December 30, 1999, Axces filed a Motion initiating Case. No. TD-2000-399, and indicated in this Motion that the transaction approved by the Commission in Case No. TM-99-601 had been abandoned. The Motion requested that the Commission cancel the Certification and Tariff of Axces Acquisition, Inc. and continue or maintain the Certification and Tariff of Axces. On January 27, 2000, Axces Acquisition, Inc. filed a pleading joining in the request of Axces to cancel the Certificate and Tariff of Axces Acquisition, Inc.

In summary, the Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff) has reviewed the motion to cancel the Certification and Tariff of Axces Acquisition, Inc., and recommends that the Commission enter an Order granting the Motion to Cancel the Certificate and Tariff of Axces Acquisition, Inc. The Staff also recommends that the Commission enter an Order maintaining or continuing the Certificate and Tariff of Axces, Inc.
