MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW New Access Communications LLC ("NAC"), by its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080 (16), states the following to the Missouri Public Service Commission (the "Commission"):

- 1. The present Application requests approval for NAC to acquire certain assets, including, but not limited to, the IXC subscriber base of Ciera Network Systems, Inc. ("Ciera"). Ciera and its senior lender, Textron Financial Corporation (collectively hereinafter, "Textron" or "Seller") have entered into a letter of intent for a voluntary foreclosure arrangement whereby certain Ciera assets will transfer to a specified assignee after a voluntary foreclosure from Ciera.
