



MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE AND
CONTINUE HEARING PREVIOUSLY SET

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

Comes now Southwest Sewer Corporation, Applicant in both
above-captioned matters, and moves this Commission to consolidate
the above-captioned matters and continue the hearing previously set
in Case No. SA-80-230, and states in support thereof as follows:

1.

That Case No. SA-80-230 is an application for a certificate of
convenience and necessity to operate as a sewer utility in Jasper
County, Missouri; that said application was filed with the Commission
on or about March 21, 1980, and that the Commission has set this
matter for hearing on September 8, 1980;

2.

That Case No. SA-81-2 is also an application for a certificate
of convenience and necessity to operate as a sewer utility in Greene
County, Missouri; that said application was filed with the Commission
on or about July 3, 1980, and that no hearing has, to date, been
established in this matter;

That both Cases No. SA-80-230 and SA-81-2 involve the same
Applicant and involve common questions of fact and law; that the

only material distinction between the two applications is the two certificated areas sought to be served;

4.


That attorney for Applicant will be out of town on vacation during the period when Case No. SA-80-230 has been set for hearing and does not expect to be back in the office until September 22, 1980;

That consolidation of these cases is sought in the interest of saving time and money in the presentation of these matters to the Commission for consideration; that continuance of the hearing in this matter is not sought in order to unduly delay or burden the orderly hearing of these matters.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that the above-captioned matters be consolidated for purposes of hearing before the Commission and that the hearing previously set in Case No. SA-80-230 for September 8, 1980, be continued, to a date to be fixed by the Commission, after September 22, 1980, and for such other and further orders that are reasonable in the circumstances.
