tain a sewer system for the public
located in an unincorporated area
within Jasper County, Missouri.

In the matter of the application of
SOUTHWEST SEWER CORPORATION for per-
mission, approval and a certificate
of convenience and necessity author-
izing it to construct, install, own,
operate, control, manage and main-
tain a sewer system for the public
located in an unincorporated area
within Greene County, Missouri.

ORDER GRANTING MOTION

On July 24, 1980, Southwest Sewer Corporation filed a Motion seeking
consolidation of the above-styled matters and a continuance of the hearing
previously set in Case No. SA-80-230.

The application in Case No. SA-80-230 was filed on March 21, 1980, and
seeks authority to operate a sewage disposal system in a portion of Jasper County,
Missouri, known as Twin Hills Subdivision being developed by Don VanHooser,
8001 Fir Road, Carl Junction, Missouri 64834. The application is presently set
for hearing in the Commission's hearing room in Jefferson City on September 8, 1980.

The application in Case No. SA-81-2 was filed on July 3, 1980, and seeks
authority to operate a sewage disposal system in a portion of Greene County,
Missouri, known as Holyoke Park 1st Addition being developed by Herm Zinter,
2209 West Cynthia, Springfield, Missouri 65807. No hearing date has been
established in that matter.

The Motion recites that since both cases involve the same Applicant and
the same supporting witnesses, that the consolidation of the cases is in the
interest of saving time and money in the presentation of the two matters to the

Commission. The Motion also recites that the attorney for the Applicant will be unavailable at the presently set hearing date of September 8, 1980.

The Commission is of the opinion that the Motion should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the hearing presently set in Case No. SA-80-230 on September 8, 1980, be, and the same is, hereby cancelled.

ORDERED: 2. That Cases No. SA-80-230 and SA-81-2 be, and the same are, hereby consolidated for hearing in the Commission's hearing room on the tenth floor of the Jefferson State Office Building, Jefferson City, Missouri, at 9:00 a.m., on the 24th day of October, 1980, at which time any interested person may offer testimony in support of or in opposition to the authority sought.

ORDERED: 3. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
