COMES NOW Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation ("Trigen"), pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.116, and for its Notice of Dismissal respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On July 9, 1999, Trigen filed its Application for Rehearing of the Commission's Assessment Order (Supplemental Order No. 53), which initiated this proceeding.
- 2. On December 21, 2000, the Commission issued an Order Setting Prehearing Conference in this case. Pursuant to this order, the parties met for a prehearing conference on January 2, 2001.
