NOTICE DIRECTING RESPONSE TO MEDIATION REQUEST

On June 28, 1999, the Foremost Insurance Company (Foremost) filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) against the Director of the Division of Manufactured Homes, Recreational Vehicles and Modular Units of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Director), alleging that Director, purportedly acting in his official capacity but allegedly without legal authority, removed or caused to be removed the Housing and Urban Development seal from the pre-owned 1988 Clayton Mobile Home owned by Foremost. The Commission issued its *Notice of Complaint* on July 1, 1999, providing 30 days for Director to file an answer, or, in the alternative, to file a request for mediation. On July 13, 1999, the Director filed his *Request for Mediation*. If Foremost agrees to mediation of this dispute, then this proceeding will be stayed pending the mediation process.

Foremost should accept or decline the request for mediation by writing to the Commission's Secretary at:

If Foremost declines the mediation request or does not respond within 15 days of the date of this notice, the Commission will proceed with this case by directing Director to file an answer to the Complaint and setting a procedural schedule and hearing date.
