ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

The Commission received a letter from Bob Whipple, the Vice President of Lubbock Radio Paging Service, Inc. d/b/a Stenocall, a competitive telecommunications company, on March 3, 1997, indicating that the company has discontinued its business in Missouri and does not plan to do business in Missouri in the future. In its Memorandum filed on July 10, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) stated it had contacted Mr. Whipple and confirmed that the company seeks to cancel its certificate of service authority granted in Case No. TA-93-180 and accompanying tariffs. Staff recommended that the Commission issue an order to cancel the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff.

Based upon the company's written request and Staff's recommendation, the Commission will cancel the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Missouri and accompanying tariff of Lubbock Radio Paging Service, Inc. d/b/a Stenocall are hereby canceled.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 29, 1997.
