## SECOND ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On August 8, 2011<sup>1</sup>, Budget Prepay, Inc. (Budget) applied for designation as a wireless Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) throughout the exchanges of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri. The Commission ordered its Staff to file a Recommendation no later than September 9, then granted Staff an extension until November 9.

On October 4, Staff filed a Second Request for Extension of Time. Staff explains that it has recently begun to issue data requests to all wireless ETC applicants, which, in turn, adds to the time Staff needs to process those applications. Staff also has several questions about Budget's wireline practices. Thus, Staff states that it needs until December 15 to file its Recommendation.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission's request for extension of time is granted.

2. The Staff of the Commission shall file its Recommendation no later than December 15, 2011.
