The Office of the Public Counsel makes the following comments on the proposed revision to the Commission rules:

## 4 CSR 240-2.015 Waiver of Rules

OPC opposes this rule revision.

The rule is too broad and does not provide adequate due process safeguards, including notice and opportunity to be heard on the proposed waiver. It does not provide a process for the waiver or any limitation on the proposed waiver. It appears that the PSC could waive its rules sua sponte without notice. At a minimum, the rule should provide that the Commission may waive or modify a rule upon application of a party, with proper notice and an opportunity to intervene, and with an adequate and reasonable opportunity to be heard, for good cause shown.

It is error for the PSC not to follow its own rules. The broad, open-ended waiver provisions essentially leaves the rules and their application solely at the PSC's discretion and whim and do not provide the predictability and protection that the rules of procedure are designed to provide.
