Applicant requests permission, approval, and a certificate of public convenience and necessity to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a sewer system for the public in an unincorporated area in St. Louis County, Missouri, as set forth on the map attached to this application as Exhibit 1, and legally described by metes and bounds attached to this application as Exhibit 2.
- 4. The feasibility study will be submitted to the Commission prior to the hearing on this matter.



5. There are no municipalities located within the proposed areas. Applicant has previously complied with all legal requirements of the St. Louis County Court by obtaining a franchise to operate in said county.

6. Said sewer system will meet all of the requirements of the Commission and the Department of Natural Resources.

7. There are no other public utilities or governmental bodies being operated or rendering sewer service within the area proposed to be served.

8. The area requested is rapidly being developed into subdivisions by developers and plans are being made to build rasi-dential homes and other establishments within the area, all of which will need adequate sewer service. Therefore, a public need exists for adequate sewer service within the area proposed to be served and the public convenience and necessity will be promoted by the granting of the authority herein requested.

9. The names and addresses of ten (10) residents of the proposed service area and/or owners of land in the proposed service area are attached as Exhibit 3.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests the Commission to grant it permission, approval, and a certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing it to install, acquire, build, construct, cwn, operate, control, manage, and maintain a sewer system for the public within the area referred to in paragraph 3 hereof and for such further orders as the Commission may deem meet and proper.
