APPLICATION OF KCP&L GREATER MISSOURI OPERATIONS COMPANY CONTAINING ITS FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE TRUE UP

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-3.161(8) and 4 CSR 240-20.090(5), KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("KCP&L-GMO") hereby respectfully submits to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") an application ("Application") containing its true up concerning its fuel adjustment clause ("FAC") to remedy an over collection of approximately \$0.29 million for the territory served as MPS and an over collection of approximately \$0.15 million for the territory served as L&P. KCP&L-GMO respectfully requests that the Commission approve the over collection amounts as calculated by KCP&L-GMO and authorize KCP&L-GMO to include those amounts in its next accumulation period. In support of its Application, KCP&L-GMO offers as follows:

1. KCP&L-GMO is a Delaware corporation with its principal office and place of business at 1200 Main Street, Kansas City, Missouri 64105. KCP&L-GMO is primarily engaged in the business of providing electric and steam utility service in Missouri to the public in its certificated areas. KCP&L-GMO is an electrical corporation and public utility as defined in Mo. Rev. Stat. § 386.020 (2000). A Certificate of Authority for a foreign corporation to do business in the State of Missouri, evidencing KCP&L-GMO's authority under the law to conduct business in the State of Missouri, was filed with the Commission in Case No. EN-2009-0164 and is incorporated herein by reference in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(G). KCP&L-GMO's

fictitious name registration was filed in Case No. EN-2009-0015 and is incorporated herein by

reference

2. KCP&L-GMO holds Certificates of Convenience and Necessity from the

Commission to transact business as an electric public utility in certain areas of the State of

Missouri and is principally engaged in the generation, transmission, distribution and sale of

electric power and energy. KCP&L-GMO has one pending action against it from any state or

federal agency or court that involve customer service or rates, which has occurred within three

years of the date of this Application. In addition, no annual report or assessment fees are overdue.

In its Report and Order issued May 17, 2007, in Case No. ER-2007-0004, the 4.

Commission approved KCP&L-GMO's use of a FAC pursuant to 4 CSR 240-3.161 and 4 CSR

240-20.090. On August 18, 2010, the Commission issued an order, in Case No. ER-2010-0385

approving KCP&L-GMO's semi-annual FAC rate schedules effective September 1, 2010.

5. As explained in the Direct Testimony of Linda Nunn, being submitted herewith,

during KCP&L-GMO's sixth recovery period, KCP&L-GMO over collected approximately

\$0.29 million for the territory served as MPS and approximately \$0.15 million for the territory

served as L&P.

6. In support of its Application and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-3.161(8)(A), KCP&L-GMO is filing the following information herewith: "1. Amount of costs that it has over-collected or under-collected through the RAM by rate class and voltage level; 2. Proposed adjustments or refunds by rate class and voltage level; [and] 3. Electric utility's short-term borrowing rate." Moreover, in further support of its Application and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-3.161(8)(B), KCP&L-GMO is submitting the following information to the Commission and serving it upon the parties: "1. Workpapers detailing how the determination of the over-collection or under-collection of costs through the RAM was made including any model inputs and outputs and the derivation of any model inputs; 2. Workpapers detailing the proposed adjustments or refunds; [and] 3. Basis for the electric utility's short-term borrowing rate."

7. Based on the information contained in this Application and provided herewith, KCP&L-GMO respectfully requests that the Commission approve the over collection amounts as calculated by KCP&L-GMO and authorize KCP&L-GMO to include those amounts in its next accumulation period.
