The Missouri Public Service Commission is required to give notice to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies when an application is filed for a certificate of service authority or for competitive classification. §§ 392.361.2, 392.440, and 392.450 RSMo 1994.

The Commission must approve a certificate of service authority for the resale of interexchange telecommunication services or local exchange services if it finds that approving the certificate is in the public interest. § 392.440 RSMo 1994. The Commission may classify a company as competitive if it finds that all the telecommunications services the company offers are competitive services. § 392.361.3 RSMo 1994. The Commission waives application of the following statutes and Commission rules for competitive companies as authorized by §§ 392.361.5 and 392.420 RSMo 1994:

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that each applicant listed in the schedule accompanying this notice has applied to the Commission for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services and/or non-switched local exchange telecommunications services under §§ 392.410 through 392.450 RSMo 1994.

Each applicant has requested competitive classification, and has filed a proposed tariff. If the Commission's staff makes a favorable

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recommendation and no request for hearing is filed, the Commission will grant certificates of service authority and competitive classification to these applicants, and approve the applicants' proposed tariffs, without a hearing.

If you wish to contest whether it is in the public interest to grant an applicant competitive status or a certificate of service authority, you may file a written application to intervene by the intervention date on the Schedule of Applicants. Address your Application to Intervene to the Executive Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, and serve copies on the applicant, the applicant's attorney, and all intervenors. Any party may object to an Application to Intervene by giving the reasons for the objection in writing. Objections must be filed with the Commission no later than ten days after the Application to Intervene was filed. You may obtain a copy of an application filed with the Commission by sending a written request to the Executive Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.

EACH APPLICANT MUST FILE a proposed tariff reflecting the rates, rules, and regulations the company intends to use for providing services in Missouri at the time of its application. The tariff must have an effective date that is at least 45 days after the filing date.
