**NOTICE OF DISMISSAL**

Comes now Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and, for its Notice of Dismissal, states as follows:

1. On April 28, 2000, OnFiber Carrier Services, Inc. ("OnFiber") filed its Application requesting authority to operate as a local exchange, basic local exchange and interexchange provider of telecommunications services on a facilities and resale basis to customers throughout Missouri.

2. On May 31, 2000, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT") timely filed its Application to Intervene, which was granted by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("the Commission") on June 19, 2000.

3. On October 27, 2000, OnFiber filed its Motion to Amend the Application of OnFiber Carrier Services, Inc. to Delete the Request for Authority to Provide Basic Local Exchange Service ("the Motion").

4. On November 17, 2000, the Commission granted the Motion.

5. Since the services that OnFiber seeks Commission authority to provide will no longer be offered in direct competition with SWBT, SWBT has no direct interest in the Commission's decision on OnFiber's Application. For this reason, SWBT files this Notice of Dismissal and requests the Commission to enter an Order dismissing SWBT from this case.
