### APPLICATION FOR INTEREXCHANGE AND NON-SWITCHED LOCAL EXCHANGE AUTHORITY AND COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION

Comes now MGC Communications, Inc. ("Applicant" or "MGC"), by and through counsel, and pursuant to Sections 392.361, 392.420, 392.430, 392.440 RSMo 1994, Section 392.410 RSMo Supp. 1999, and 4 CSR 240-2.060(6), files this Verified Application requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission (hereinafter "the Commission") issue an order that:

- (a) grants Applicant a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services, as herein more specifically defined, pursuant to Chapter 392 RSMo;
- (b) grants competitive status to Applicant and Applicant's requested services; and
- (c) waives certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to Sections 392.361 and 392.420 RSMo 1994, consistent with the Commission's past treatment of other certificated providers of competitive interexchange/private line telecommunications services.

In support of its request, Applicant states that:

1. Applicant is a corporation formed and operating under the laws of the State of Nevada and is duly authorized to transact business in the State of Missouri. Pursuant to the relevant provisions of 4 CSR 240-2.060, a certificate from the Missouri Secretary of State's Office is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as **Appendix A**.

3. By this Application, Applicant seeks authority to provide various types of intrastate interexchange and non-switched, private line local exchange telecommunications services to business customers throughout the state of Missouri. Such services may include, but are not limited to: message toll service (MTS), WATS, 800 service, switched inbound service, switched outbound service, dedicated private line services, and calling card service. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060(6)(C), Applicant's proposed tariff bearing a forty-five day effective date, which more specifically describes Applicant's proposed service offerings at this time, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as **Appendix B**. Applicant in the future may seek to expand its particular service offerings beyond those listed in its initial tariff, in which case, Applicant will make the appropriate tariff filings to expand its service offerings under the Commission's usual tariff filing procedure at that time.

- 4. Applicant requests that it and all its services proposed herein be classified as competitive. Applicant's proposed services herein fall within the category of the types of services which have routinely been authorized by the Commission for numerous other competitive carriers upon verified application without the need for evidentiary hearings. Applicant's proposed services will be subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation; granting this Application will allow greater price and service options for telecommunications customers and will be in the public interest. Granting Applicant's requested competitive classifications is consistent with past Commission treatment of other competitive certificated interexchange/non-switched local exchange carriers and will encourage competition consistent with the public policy of Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter 392 RSMo.
- 5. Applicant is willing to comply with all applicable Commission orders, rules and regulations. Applicant requests however, pursuant to Section 392.420 RSMo 1994, that the Commission at minimum waive the application of the following rules and statutory provisions as they relate to the regulation of Applicant to the extent that they previously and routinely have been waived for other certificated competitive interexchange/non-switched local exchange carriers:

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> MGC Communications, Inc. received its conditional certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service in portions of the State of Missouri in Case No. TA-2000-453 (Order issued March 22, 2000). In that Order, the Commission already has classified MGC as a competitive company. However, in the interest of following the standard Commission practice of granting competitive classification as an integral part of the interexchange certificate application case process, and to be fully compliant with 4 CSR 240-2.060(6)(A), MGC has included its request for competitive classification as part of this Application.

6. Applicant is financially capable of providing the services proposed. Applicant also possesses the necessary technical and managerial expertise and experience necessary to provide the services it proposes to offer at standards that will meet or exceed all service standards established by the Commission. The Commission recently found Applicant in all respects qualified to provide basic local telecommunications service in Case No. TA-2000-453 (Order issued March 22, 2000).

- 7. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060(1) (K), Applicant states that it does not have any pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this Application.
- 8. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(L), Applicant states that no Commission annual report or assessment fees are overdue.

WHEREFORE, MGC Communications, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission:

1) expeditiously grant it a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate, interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services within the State of Missouri; 2) grant Applicant and its proposed services competitive status; and 3) waive the application of the above-referenced statutes and Commission rules; all consistent with past Commission practice and the

Commission's treatment of other certificated, competitive providers of intrastate interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services.
