**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On April 28, 2005, the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Missouri Public Service Commission and America's Home Brokers, Inc. filed a Stipulated Agreement. That agreement provides, *inter alia*, that "America's Home will pay a \$1,000.00 penalty to the Commission within ten (10) days of the Commission's approval of this Stipulated Agreement." The Staff of the Commission will be ordered to file a pleading reciting the statutory basis of the Commission's authority to assess and collect such a penalty.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That, no later than May 7, 2005, the Staff of the Commission shall file a pleading reciting the statutory basis of the Commission's authority to assess and collect the penalty in the Stipulated Agreement.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 29, 2005.
