**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**


In the Second Report and Order issued on October 5, 2004, in Case Number IO-2001-1083, the Commission directed its staff to investigate the services provided by Universal Telecom, Inc., and Missouri State Discount Telephone, and to file a recommendation as to whether the certificates of those companies should be canceled. This order will serve to establish a case for that investigation, and set a date for the filing of the recommendation.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That, no later than December 8, 2004, the Staff of the Commission shall file in this case file a report on its investigation into the services provided by Universal Telecom, Inc., and Missouri State Discount Telephone together with a recommendation as to whether the certificates should be canceled.

2. That this order shall become effective on November 8, 2004.
