Dear Customer:

On November 08,2005 Taneycomo Highlands INC.submitted a request for permanent increases in its current sewer rates to the Missouri Public Service Commission, Under the provisions of the commissions small company rate increase procedure.

By its request, the company is seeking increases in its customer rates intended to generate an increase in its annual sewer operating revenues of \$9,250. (approximately 212.44%). The company believes this increase in its operating revenues is necessary due to increases in operation and maintenance expenses; Increases in the commissions annual utility assessment; And increases in the Department Of Natural Resources annual sewer discharge permit fees. In its request, the company recognized that changes to its general business practices, Customer service practices, and general tariff provisions and the design of its customer rates, might occur. Set out at the end of this notice is a table that includes a comparison of the company's current customer rates and the current rates increased by 212.44%. A Monthly bill comparison is also shown.

In the near future, The staff of the Public Service Commission will conduct an independent audit of the company's books and records, and an investigation of the company's business and system operations. Based upon the audit and investigation, the commission staff will develop its positions regarding the company's requested increase in its annual operating revenues. Additionally, the commission staff will develop positions regarding the need for changes in the company's general tariff provisions, business operations and system operations in the design of the company's customer rates.

The office of the Public Counsel(OPC), a state agency responsible for representing the interests of utility consumers before the commission, may also conduct its own audit and investigation, but, at a minimum will review the results of the commission staff's audit and investigation.
