**EMPIRE’S SUPPLEMENT TO JOINT APPLICATION**

COMES NOW The Empire District Electric Company (Empire), and as a Supplement to the Joint Application, respectfully states as follows:

1. On February 1, 2008, The Empire District Electric Company and White River Valley Electric Cooperative (White River) filed a Joint Application asking the Commission to approve a change in electric supplier for a piece of property located near Hollister, Missouri. White River currently provides electric service to the subject property, but the owner of the property intends to develop a water park and arena, which would be served by Empire.
2. The Commission Staff has asked Empire to provide additional information concerning the background of this proposed change of supplier. As a supplement to the Joint Application, Empire provides the following additional explanation.
3. As stated in the Joint Application, White River currently provides electrical service to a house located at 801 Birch Street, Hollister, Missouri. The customer at this address is Hollister Interchange Development Company, LLC (HIDC), which is also the owner. The property owner will be paying White River to remove its lines from the property to allow for future construction.
4. The lines being removed by White River to accommodate the construction on HDIC’s property will no longer be of use to White River following the proposed change of supplier. This is due to the fact that White River will be unable to set any new meters off of


these facilities as they reside inside the city limits of Hollister, Missouri. Therefore, any and all new meters set within the subject area will be served by Empire.

WHEREFORE, Empire respectfully requests that the Commission consider the supplement to the Joint Application and, thereafter, issue its order:

(a) Finding that the change of electric supplier proposed in the Joint Application is in the public interest and approving the proposed change of electric supplier; and

(b) Granting such other relief as is deemed necessary to accomplish the purposes of the Joint Application.


