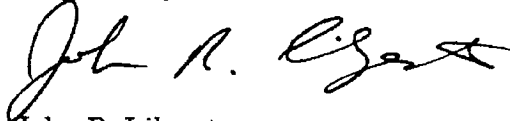

Pursuant to section 203 of the Federal Power Act (FPA), 16 U.S.C.

§ 824b, and Part 33 of the Commission's regulations, 18 C.F.R. § 33.1 et seq.,

UtiliCorp United Inc. (UtiliCorp) hereby submits this application for authorization for UtiliCorp to transfer control over certain specified transmission facilities of its Missouri Public Service, St. Joseph Light and Power and WestPlains Energy-Kansas divisions to the Midwest Independent System Operator, Inc. (MISO).

I. INTRODUCTION

On August 20, 2001, UtiliCorp filed with the Commission an application in Docket No. EC01-142-000 for authorization for UtiliCorp to transfer control over the transmission facilities of its Missouri Public Service, St. Joseph Light and Power and WestPlains Energy-Kansas divisions to the MISO. The Commission granted the application on September 13, 2001. UtiliCorp United Inc., 96 FERC ¶ 62,256 (2001). Subsequently, UtiliCorp discovered that several affected transmission facilities were omitted from the list of facilities to be transferred contained in Exhibit G to the August 20 application. The sole purpose of this application is to request authorization for the transfer of such inadvertently omitted facilities. The additional facilities are listed in Exhibit G hereto.

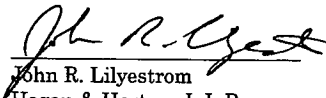
