

which the parties believe will result in a unanimous stipulation and agreement and that the parties needed additional time to continue discussions and complete the stipulation and agreement. Staff stated that the parties requested an extension of time until November 4, 1999, in which to file either a unanimous stipulation and agreement or a proposed procedural schedule. Staff stated that no one would be prejudiced by the grant of additional time in which to file.

The Commission will order that the deadline for filing a procedural schedule be extended.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the motion of the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission for an extension of time to file a procedural schedule is granted.
2. That the parties shall file a procedural schedule no later than 3:00 PM on November 4, 1999.
3. That the procedural schedule shall include dates for the filing of testimony and for an evidentiary hearing.

4. That this order shall become effective on October 29, 1999.

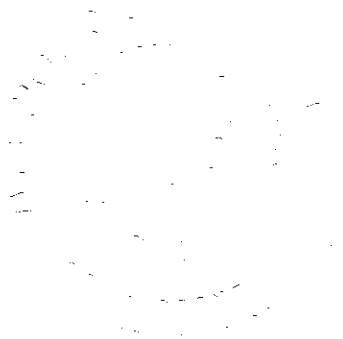
