## **ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE**

On August 6, 2001, Environmental Utilities, LLC, filed an application with the Commission requesting a certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing it to operate a water system in the Golden Glade Subdivision in an unincorporated portion of Camden County, Missouri.

Proper parties should be given notice and an opportunity to intervene in this matter. The Records Department of the Commission shall send a copy of this order to the County Commission of Camden County, and to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. The Information Officer of the Commission shall send notice of this application to the members of the General Assembly who represent Camden County, and to the newspapers that serve Camden County as listed in the newspaper directory of the current Official Manual of the State of Missouri.

Proper persons wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene with the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission. Copies of the application to intervene should be sent to the parties listed below.

The requirement of a hearing has been fulfilled when all those having a desire to be heard are offered an opportunity to be heard. If no proper party is granted intervention, and neither the Commission's Staff, nor the Office of the Public Counsel, request a hearing, the Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary and that Environmental Utilities may submit its evidence in support of the application by verified statement. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989).
