## ORDER SCHEDULING A PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND DIRECTING THE PARTIES TO FILE A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On August 6, 2001, Environmental Utilities, LLC, filed an application seeking a certificate of authority to construct and operate a water system in a subdivision in Camden County, Missouri. So that this matter may proceed expeditiously, the Commission will direct the parties to submit a proposed procedural schedule leading to a hearing at which all contested issues may be decided. In order to assist with the development of the procedural schedule, the Commission will schedule a prehearing conference.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That a prehearing conference shall be held on September 19, 2001, beginning at 10:00 a.m. The prehearing conference shall be held at the Commission's offices at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. - 2. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than September 26, 2001. The procedural schedule shall include dates for the filing of testimony and a hearing.
