ORDER DIRECTING FILING


On August 16, 1999, Harcourt Telco, L.L.C., doing business as Maverix.com, Inc. (Maverix or Applicant), filed an application with the Commission seeking approval of an interconnection agreement with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) under the provisions of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act). That application is deficient in that it does not include evidence of the registration of the Applicant's fictitious name with the Missouri Secretary of State as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(A). Maverix must submit such evidence or its application will be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Harcourt Telco, L.L.C., doing business as Maverix.com, Inc., shall, within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Order, file with this Commission evidence of the registration of its fictitious name with the Missouri Secretary of State.

2. That this Order shall become effective on September 5, 1999.
