ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF CORPORATE NAME AND APPROVING REVISED ADOPTION NOTICE

On October 4, 1999, Charities Network International, Inc. (CNI) filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) a first revised adoption notice with an effective date of November 4, 1999, designed to reflect that it has changed its corporate name to Net One International, Inc. CNI also filed a registration of a fictitious name and an amended certificate of authority of a foreign corporation, both issued by the Missouri Secretary of State, dated September 17, 1999, showing the new name, Net One International, Inc. On October 14, 1999, CNI submitted a substitute tariff page correcting typographical errors.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum on October 26, 1999, stating that it had reviewed CNI's filings and revised adoption notice and had no objection to their approval. Staff recommended that the name change be recognized and the revised adoption notice be approved to become effective November 4, 1999.

The Commission has reviewed CNI's filings, the revised adoption notice, and Staff's recommendation, and finds that the change of name should be recognized. The Commission further finds that the revised adoption notice reflecting the change of name should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the change of name from Charities Network International, Inc. to Net One International, Inc. is acknowledged.
- 2. That the revised adoption notice denominated Net One International, Inc. Missouri P.S.C. No. 1, 1st Revised Adoption Notice Page 1, filed under tariff number 200000316, is approved to become effective on November 4, 1999.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on November 4, 1999.
 - 4. That this case may be closed on November 5, 1999.
