ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF NAME AND APPROVING TARIFF

Common Concerns, Inc. (CCI) filed an adoption notice reflecting the change of the company's name to Cash Back Rebates LD.com, Inc. (Cash Back) on October 28, 1999. The proposed adoption notice tariff effective date is November 28, 1999. Cash Back included with its filing a copy of its Amended Certificate of Authority for a Foreign Corporation issued by the Missouri Secretary of State's office on October 5, 1999.

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a document entitled Staff Recommendation with an attached memorandum on November 10 stating that Staff had reviewed Cash Back's proposed adoption notice. Staff stated that it had no objections to the proposed adoption notice, and recommended that the Commission issue an order approving the corporate change of name and approving adoption notice.

The Commission has reviewed Cash Back's filing and finds that the name change should be recognized and the proposed adoption notice should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the adopted name "Cash Back Rebates LD.com, Inc." is acknowledged.

2. That tariff file No. 200000412, submitted in Case No. To-2000-300 by Cash Back Rebates LD.com, Inc., is hereby approved for service to be rendered on or after November 28, 1999.
