## ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On January 24, 2000, Touch 1 Communications, Inc. (Touch 1) submitted a tariff filing to eliminate several products and expire another. The company stated that the changes are necessary because the company is converting to a new billing software package that will not support the products that are being eliminated. The tariff revisions indicate an effective date of February 23, 2000. However, Touch 1 requested expedited consideration of the tariffs because the new software package will go into effect on February 15. Touch 1 requests that the Commission allow its tariff revisions to become effective on February 15.

On February 3, Staff filed a recommendation and memorandum indicating that Staff has reviewed the tariff sheets submitted by Touch 1 and recommends that the Commission approve them as submitted with an expedited effective date of February 15.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation and finds that Touch 1 has demonstrated good cause for its request that its proposed tariff become effective in less than thirty days. The submitted tariff sheets shall be approved to become effective on February 15.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed by Touch 1 Communications, Inc., on January 24, 2000, and assigned tariff number 200000650, are approved to become effective on February 15, 2000. The tariff sheets approved are:
