ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On April 3, 2000, Fidelity Communication Services I, Inc. (Fidelity), filed a local market trial tariff for its basic local exchange service. The tariff has an effective date of May 30, 2000, and is designed to allow Fidelity to do field trials of its network prior to offering its service to the general public. Fidelity requested that the Commission expedite its consideration of the tariff.

On April 5, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation indicating that Staff has reviewed the tariff submitted by Fidelity and recommends that the Commission approve it as submitted. Staff stated that the "proposed local market trial will involve a maximum of 100 participants and is scheduled to conclude on December 31, 2000." Staff also stated that this local market trial tariff was similar to one previously approved for AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (Tariff File No. 9800156).

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation and finds that the tariff sheet should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the local market trial tariff filed by Fidelity Communications Services I, Inc., on April 3, 2000, and assigned tariff number 200000903, is approved to become effective on April 27, 2000. The tariff sheet approved is:

- 3. That this case may be closed on April 28, 2000.
