ORDER CONTINUING FILING DATE FOR MEMORANDUM

On October 6, 1993, the Commission's Staff (Staff) filed a letter with the Commission requesting a continuation for the filing of an ordered memorandum. On August 3, 1993, the Commission in its Order Establishing Docket And Setting Intervention Date herein directed the parties in this case to convene two technical conferences and to file a memorandum by November 4, 1993, setting out: (1) the issues agreed to be considered when allocating costs between St. Joseph Light & Power Company's electric, gas and steam jurisdictions, (2) the proper test year, and (3) a procedural schedule. Staff states that at the conclusion of the second conference, the parties concluded that it would be premature to file such a memorandum. Staff states that the parties propose to continue negotiations and to hold an additional technical conference on January 12, 1994. Staff states that the parties request that the date for filing the memorandum be continued to February 14, 1994.

After considering the Staff's letter, the Commission determines that it would be appropriate to grant the requested continuance for the filing of the ordered memorandum.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the memorandum previously ordered to be filed by the parties specifying the agreed-upon issues, proper test year, and proposed procedural

schedule on November 4, 1993, be hereby continued for filing on February 14, 1994.

2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
