On July 22, 2015, the Commission issued its Revised Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. On July 31, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois ("ATXI") applied for rehearing.

The Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear."<sup>1</sup> The Commission finds that the applicant failed to establish such a sufficient reason. Thus, the Commission will deny the application.
