## ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION TO THE CITY OF NIXA

The Commission received no response to the City of Nixa's ("City") *Application to Intervene* ("motion")<sup>1</sup> within the time allowed by regulation. <sup>2</sup> The Commission may grant the motion if:

- (A) The proposed intervenor . . . has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case; or
- (B) Granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. [<sup>3</sup>]

In support of the motion, the City alleges that it has a contract to sell transmission assets to the applicant, conditioned in part on the outcome of this action. Also, the City states that it has specifically studied the costs and benefits to certain customers, and protections needed for certain customers, so it has special knowledge of those matters. Those circumstances meet the regulation's requirements. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.
