#### Case No. TA-88-218

In the matter of the application of American Operator Services, Inc. for a certificate of service authority to provide Intrastate Operator-Assisted Resold Telecommunications Services.

#### ORDER AND MOTICE

On February 26, 1988, American Operator Services, Inc. (Applicant) filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to provide operator-assisted resale of intrastate telecommunications services in the State of Missouri.

This application is filed pursuant to Section 392.440, RSMo Supp. 1987, which provides that any company offering the resale of either local exchange or interexchange telecommunications service must first obtain a certificate of service authority. Section 392.440 further provides that the Commission shall approve such applications upon a showing of the Applicant and a finding by the Commission, after notice and hearing, that the grant of authority is in the public interest.

The Commission is of the opinion that proper parties should be given an opportunity to intervene in this matter. Applications to intervene shall be filed by the date set forth below with the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102 and copies sent to:

The Commission determines that the Secretary of the Commission shall send a copy of this Order to any person or entities known to the Telecommunications

Department of the Public Service Commission to be rendering identical or similar

service within the State of Missouri, as well as to each telephone company rendering local exchange service and each provider of interexchange service within the State of Missouri. In addition, the Secretary shall send notice of this Order to the publisher of each newspaper located in the State as listed in the Newspaper Directory of the current Official Manual of the State of Missouri.

Any proper entity desiring to intervene in this proceeding shall file its application to intervene within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.

The Commission determines that its Staff should be directed to inquire into Applicant's prior and proposed service offerings as to quality of service, customer relations, rates and billing process. Specifically, the Commission desires a report and recommendation from its Staff containing as a minimum information on:

- 1. Access to local emergency services for Applicant's end users;
- Provision of notice to potential end users of the provider's name, rates and complaint procedures;
- 3. The procedure for billing end users including whether Applicant proposes to request the local exchange carrier to disconnect end users for nonpayment of AOS bills;
- 4. The proposed rates to be charged;
- 5. The manner of handling the end users' complaints; and
- The quality of service the Applicant proposes to provide, such as the time necessary to process the end user's calls.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That any interested party wishing to intervene or request a hearing in this case shall notify the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission and the aforementioned party on or before the 5th day of May, 1988.

ORDERED: 2. That the Secretary of the Commission is directed hereby to send notice as stated herein.

ORDERED: 3. That the Commission's Staff is directed hereby to file its report and recommendation as to this application as outlined supra.

ORDERED: 4. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
