ORDER REGARDING KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S SECOND MOTION TO COMPEL DISCOVERY

On May 11, 1999, GST Steel Company (GST) filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL). Thereafter, the parties have engaged in vigorous discovery, requiring several orders from this Commission to resolve disputes.

On October 13, 1999, KCPL filed its Second Motion to Compel Discovery. GST has filed no response to KCPL's Second Motion to Compel. The Commission's practice rules allow ten days to respond to a motion. 4 CSR 240-2.080(12). Ten days have passed without response from GST; therefore, the motion shall be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the motion to compel discovery filed by Kansas City
Power & Light Company on October 13, 1999, is sustained. GST Steel
Company shall have 15 days from the effective date of this Order within



which to provide the requested discovery to Kansas City Power & Light Company.

2. That this order shall become effective on November 16, 1999.


