## ORDER DENYING REHEARING

On July 13, 2000, the Commission issued its Report and Order herein, following an evidentiary hearing on April 17 and 18, 2000, and the matter having been fully briefed by the parties. On July 24, 2000, GS Technology Operating Company, Inc., doing business as GST Steel Company (GST), timely filed its Application for Rehearing. Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) responded in opposition on August 3, 2000.
